As part of its educational development effort, the University of Clermont Auvergne will provide a financial support for students enrolled in some of its Master's programs, via a 'Graduate Track' system. The Master's degrees in Earth and Atmospheric sciences offered by the Observatoire de Physique du Globe de Clermont-Ferrand are involved in this program.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of their academic record, their motivation, and their study project. The amount of this support is 500 € per month over a 16-month period, which covers all course sessions.

The application file should contain:

- (1) A curriculum vitae.
- (2) A cover letter explaining the study plan and the motivation for studying at University Clermont Auvergne.
- (3) Transcript of undergraduate diploma.
- (4) Two letters of support from professors or any person who worked with or supervised the candidate in a scientific or academic context.
